FORMATION AT HOME / PACING SCHEDULE (CHILD):

At a child's baptism, according to the Rite of Baptism in the Catholic Church, the parents of the child are asked the following question: "You have asked to have your child baptized. In doing so you are accepting the responsibility of training him (her) in the practice of the faith. It will be your duty to bring him (her) up to keep God's commandments as Christ taught us, by loving God and our neighbor. Do you clearly understand what you are undertaking?" In order for the child to be baptized, the parents (or at least the Catholic party, if only one parent of the child is Catholic) must accept this responsibility.

In order to faithfully fulfill this commitment, it is vitally important that parents be intimately involved in the Sacramental Preparation of their child(ren). To that end, the following schedule lays out a SUGGESTED pacing schedule for 2nd Grade families that choose to watch BLESSED as a part of the parish's First Reconciliation/First Communion Sacramental Preparation:

FORMATION AT HOME / PACING SCHEDULE (PARENT):

At a child's baptism, according to the Rite of Baptism in the Catholic Church, the parents of the child are asked the following question: "You have asked to have your child baptized. In doing so you are accepting the responsibility of training him (her) in the practice of the faith. It will be your duty to bring him (her) up to keep God's commandments as Christ taught us, by loving God and our neighbor. Do you clearly understand what you are undertaking?" In order for the child to be baptized, the parents (or at least the Catholic party, if only one parent of the child is Catholic) must accept this responsibility.

In order to faithfully fulfill this commitment, it is vitally important that parents be intimately involved in the ongoing Sacramental Preparation of their child(ren). To that end, we are working to equip parents with the skills and knowledge necessary so that they can assist forming their children in the faith! This year, we will be utilizing an online platform called, FORMED, as part of our Sacramental Prep parent meetings. All 2nd grade parents are REQUIRED to access and view the following information/videos for FORGIVEN and PRESENCE prior to our parent meetings. There is a total amount of approx 5 hrs worth of video content.

Below are instructions for accessing the appropriate videos as well as "due dates":

INSTRUCTIONS

STEP 1: Create an account on FORMED.org (You have access to a FREE account through St. Catherine of Siena!) Just visit <https://formed.org/signup> to get started.

STEP 2: Once you've created your account, sign in to FORMED at www.formed.org

STEP 3: After signing in, locate the search bar to search for "Forgiven" and/or "Presence" (by Augustine Institute).

STEP 4: Complete the viewing of "Forgiven: The Transforming Power of Confession" before attending the 1st Reconciliation parent meeting while using the accompanying study guide (**DUE: NOVEMBER 14**):

FORGIVEN, Session 1: "Where are You?" (31:26)

FORGIVEN, Session 2: "An Encounter with Mercy" (26:54)

FORGIVEN, Session 3: "Embraced in Mercy: The Rite Explained" (33:50)

FORGIVE, Bonus Video: "Answering Common Questions about Confession" (38:07)
