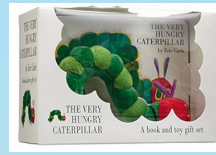
Emily Of New Moon By L.M. Montgomery

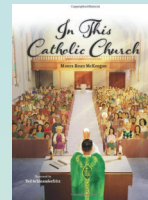
The Very Hungry Caterpillar Book & Plush By Eric Carle

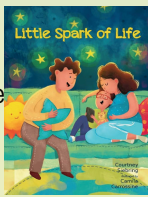
Mother Cabrini: A Heart For the World By Claudia Cangilla McAdam. Illustrated by Richard Cowdrey

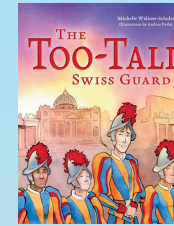

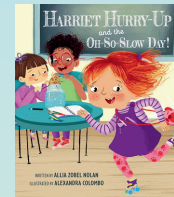
The Too-Tall Swiss Guard By Michelle Widmer-Schultz

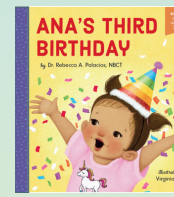
Harriet Hurry-Up and the Oh-So-Slow Day! By All Zobel Nolan

Rhyming picture book looks at why Harriet's impatience gets the better of her but with God's help she can slow down. Surprise ending that kids will enjoy! **\$14.99**



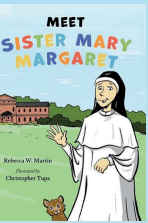
Ana's Third Birthday By Dr. Rebecca A. Palacios

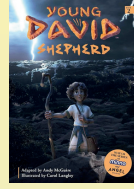
Young David Warrior (Book #1)
